- Will include one constructed response question.
- This one will also include the extended writing response question where students will plan scratch paper then respond to the prompt in essay form (informational or opinion) aiming for our 5 paragraph paper.
- Time limits for this section are in the chart below.

## April 19, 12:00 PM: ELA section 2 & 3

- Will include selected response questions (multiple choice).
- Will include constructed and extended constructed response questions (complete sentence answers with the second one using our RACE strategies)
- Will contain field test items (testing the question but doesn't count in scores).
- Time limits for both sections are in the chart below.

## April 21, 8:55 AM: Math section 1

- Combination of computation, word problems, and math vocabulary
- Will include selected response questions (multiple choice).
- Will include constructed and extended constructed response questions (constructed response may mean drawing a picture for this, extended constructed is complete sentences using RACE strategies).
- Will contain field test items (testing the question but doesn't count in scores).
- Time limits for both sections are in the chart below.

## April 24, 12:00 PM: Math section 2

- Combination of computation, word problems, and math vocabulary
- Will include constructed and extended constructed response questions (constructed response may mean drawing a picture for this, extended constructed is complete sentences using RACE strategies).
- Will contain field test items (testing the question but doesn't count in scores).
- Time limits for both sections are in the chart below.
